

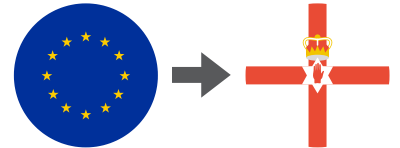
# Shipping by Air from EU27 to Northern Ireland



## All you need to know about The Windsor Framework

### Did you know?

From 30 September 2024, new rules for shipping data and commercial invoice requirements will be implemented for air shipments from EU27 to Northern Ireland.



### What do shippers need to do?

#### 1 Provide item-level clear goods descriptions, values and commodity codes

Please specify each item in the shipment with its value, commodity code, weight, and a concise description, eg. "Ladies woven 100% cotton blouse", "Men's leather shoes" or "iPhone" instead of a general one.

#### 2 Provide full international shipment data

UPS is required to provide Safety & Security declarations for air shipments from EU27 to Northern Ireland via Import Control System 2 (ICS2), therefore shippers must provide full international shipment data, including commercial invoices to meet these obligations.

### What information is required from you ?



Element	All Shipments
Commercial Invoice	Required
6 Digit HS Code	Required
Commodity description of goods at item level	Required
Value and currency at item level	Required



From 30 September 2024 air imports from EU27 must comply **on arrival** to Northern Ireland. This means that UPS will request the specified requirements above **prior** to the 30 September deadline to accommodate for transit time to Northern Ireland.
